Dear Mr Wilson,

Overseas Premium

I have pleasure in informing you that the Council have awarded an Overseas Premium to you, Mr Wilkinson and Mr Andronov for your paper on 'Barrages of the Indus Basin Project' which you presented jointly to the Institution. The Premium was instituted in 1906 and the income derived from a fund formerly applied to the reward of merit amongst students of the Royal Indian College, Coopers Hill. Two premiums are awarded annually to the two best papers received during the year on a subject connected with works carried out outside the British Isles.

The value of the Premium is £40 and the Council have directed that it be divided equally between you and your co-authors. The award is accompanied by a certificate which will be presented to you at the Awards Ceremony prior to the Annual General Meeting on Tuesday, 12 June 1973, at 5.30 p.m. Would you please let me know whether you will be able to attend this meeting.
